Forms and Templates that are within the Ontario Legal Framework

A recent research study published by the Law Commission of Ontario found that many forms used for HCC, ACP and GoC do not reflect the Ontario Legal Framework. The use of such forms may result in a denial of patient's decision-making rights and put health care providers at risk of professional misconduct and legal liability. Obtain clarity and guidance of how to edit and or develop forms and templates within your organization as they relate to HCC, ACP and GoC conversations, including what information you are obligated to obtain and how best to capture that information.
